Construction may still be underway, but we recently caught wind of a home on Lake Minnetonka designed by Jeff Murphy that's inspired in part by Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis Jr., and pals. "Our clients were looking for a home unlike any other on the lake and were intrigued

by midcentury modern homes, especially '60s-era Rat Pack-inspired architecture," Murphy says. "We used soaring timbers to support roofs that extend out 25 feet in some areas. The site has incredible views which are captured by massive glass walls and retractable doors on the lake side, which open to a pool just steps from the interior.
